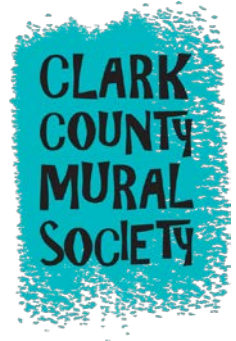

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Murals have become a unique and appealing way of increasing tourism and improving commerce. Clark County Mural Society has been working toward a vision of artistic identity and cultural richness in Vancouver, Washington since 2004. We currently have over 25 murals to date, with a much larger vision.



Our goal is to become one of the key mural destinations for tourism on the West Coast. In the next five years, through the annual Summer of Murals competition and other mural projects, we plan to bring Vancouver's number of murals to over 100. Mural destinations boast increased tourism which results in significant tax revenues.

CCMS has developed a project plan that will coordinate and promote public mural art through an annual festival speeding us toward our goal, while it brings the community together around art. Through the organized efforts of the Clark County Mural Society, this program will rely on corporate sponsors, grant and private funding as well as public participation and community involvement.

Please join us in pictorially preserving and celebrating the art, history and culture of Vancouver while increasing the charm and character of our city for residents and visitors alike. We will take pride in:

- Promoting economic development by increasing tourism, business and tax revenues, and property values

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# ARTIST Expectations



The CCMS Task Force has recruited property owners in the **Fourth Plain Corridor**, rapidly becoming the Arts & Entertainment District of the community, to allow the usage of 3 outdoor walls on their properties for 3 murals. Each will tell a special story of the “**International District**”, beautify the environment, and help build Vancouver as a “destination location”.

Statistics show that tourism monies spent on arts & cultural activities exceed those spent on sports activities, demonstrating that the Summer of Murals project will contribute to the health of the Vancouver economy.

## **Your responsibilities will be:**

- Sign a contract with CCMS
- Fill Out W-9
- Adhere to rules and procedures outlined in the Artist Rules Packet and those additionally added by building owners.
- Complete project awarded by CCMS in designated timeline periods.
- Allow us to provide identification and promotional wall painting

## **Our responsibilities are:**

- Planning and deployment of the Summer of Murals competition
- Providing support during process
- Lesion between suppliers, artist, and building owners
- Future maintenance and upkeep of the mural

# 2018 ARTIST Theme

## **International District**

**The Fourth Plain Corridor is a socially and economically diverse community, and has long been known as Vancouver’s “International District.” This diversity is reflected in the residents that live and work nearby, and in the businesses that line the corridor, including restaurants that serve international cuisine, ethnic food markets, and culturally specific service providers. The theme for the 2018 Fourth Plain Summer of Murals is the International District. Like the businesses mentioned above, competitive submissions will reflect the diverse culture heritage of the area, and connect with and/or celebrate the international food, culture, music, art, and heritage of Fourth Plain residents.**

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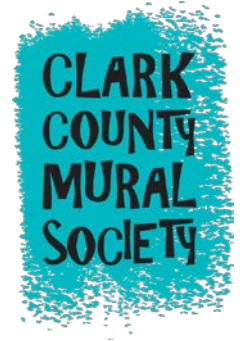

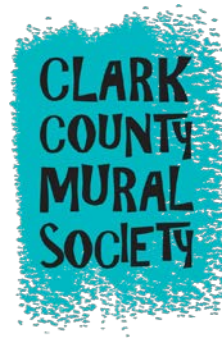

- August 18th – Painting Complete

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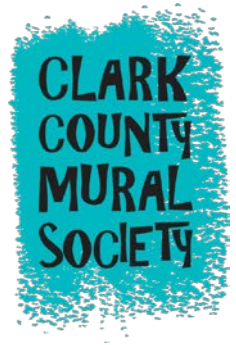

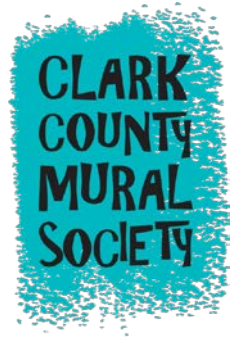
